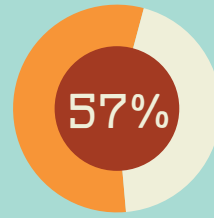


FIREWOOD FOR HOME HEATING

419 bundles of firewood were purchased in Colorado, New Mexico, Utah and Wyoming. Live insects emerged from 47% of those bundles over 18 months.

OUTREACH WORKS.

With proactive outreach and education, firewood sources for home heating in Wisconsin went from 55 miles away to 22 miles in 12 years.

Start stacking firewood in spring to dry. Seasoning it for at least 6 months in a covered shed makes it burn hotter and cleaner.

Live trees can have a 45-55% moisture content when first cut. When properly covered and dried, moisture content can drop to 17%.

Over 89,000 households in Ohio used wood for heat in 2016 — up 82% since 2000.
